Rules of Entry:

The Title is "Remembrance". As 2018 is the Centenary of Armistice we would like the rocks to be painted to reflect this.

Rocks should be no larger than 3" x 3" (7.5cm x 7.5cm). Each individual entry, together with a completed and signed copy this form must be placed inside a sealable "freezer bag" and taken to the collection point at the Royal British Legion, Eversley Road, Arborfield, RG2 9PR.

Collection dates and times will be published on www.arborfieldrbl.org.uk.

Entries will be accepted with an individual donation per stone (*donation is decided by the entrant*), up to a maximum of 5 entries per person (*one form per entry is required, and each entry must be separately packaged*).

The competition will run from 10:00 am on the 30th September 2018 until 4:00 pm on the 28th October 2018. No entries will be accepted after this time.

Terms and Conditions:

All entries, except Winners and Runners-Up in each category, will be on display at the Remembrance Day Parade. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed entries in each category will be displayed at the Royal British Legion Club after the parade where, following the presentation of awards, the prize-winning rocks will be released to be either re-hidden or kept as a memento of the event.

Please note that names, ages & pictures will be taken of the rocks and competition winners, to be published on the website and also Parish News and social media pages. Copyright on the photos will be held by organisers.

Unfortunately, no other entries will be able to be returned after judging so entering the competition you agree to abide by the rules for your rock entries to be released and not returned.

The Judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered in to. No responsibility will be taken by the organisers for loss or damage to any entries.

Proceeds from the competition donations will be split equally, with 50% to the Poppy Appeal Fund and 50% towards our fund raising for a Memorial Bench, which is estimated at £1,200 per bench.
